



BATHTUB SAFETY GUIDE

**NEVER LEAVE A CHILD UNSUPERVISED IN THE BATHTUB.
BATH SEATS ARE NOT A SAFETY DEVICE AND DO NOT REPLACE
ARMS-REACH AND CONSTANT EYES-ON SUPERVISION.**

Bathtub drownings are most common in children one and under but can happen at any age.

After pools, more children drown in bathtubs than anywhere else in the home.

**Drowning can happen in less than a minute.
It is fast and silent. Do not step away for even a moment.**

Use no-slip strips in the tub and a no-slip mat on the floor outside of the tub.

Always check the temperature of the water.
