

BATHTUB SAFETY GUIDE

NEVER LEAVE A CHILD UNSUPERVISED IN THE BATHTUB.

BATH SEATS ARE NOT A SAFETY DEVICE AND DO NOT REPLACE

ARMS-REACH AND CONSTANT EYES-ON SUPERVISION.

Bathtub drownings are most common in children one and under but can happen at any age.

After pools, more children drown in bathtubs than anywhere else in the home.

Drowning can happen in less than a minute. It is fast and silent. Do not step away for even a moment.

Use no-slip strips in the tub and a no-slip mat on the floor outside of the tub.

Always check the temperature of the water.
