



POOLSIDE SAFETY GUIDE

CASTING HOPE FOR SAFER SWIMMERS

BARRIERS:

Safeguard your pool with a 4-sided pool fence with self-latching gate, door locks & alarms.

ROUTINES:

Create strong routines for entering the pool with adult permission.

ENGAGEMENT:

Always be in the water with unskilled swimmers.

SUPERVISION:

Designate someone to be the water guardian to actively supervise during swim times.

PLAY:

Play with your child and always keep them within arm's reach.

CLEAN UP:

Ensure that barriers are in place and that toys and temptations are removed from pool area when swim time is over.

SWIM AIDS:

Accept that a child reliant upon a floatation device is not a safe, competent, or independent "swimmer."

PHOTOS:

Post or share swim time photos later. Do not divide your attention.

PREPARE:

- *PURSUE SAFE, EFFECTIVE SWIM LESSONS
- *LEARN CPR
